As we continue to navigate our changed and changing realities I was honored to be re-elected by the synod assembly to continue to serve as your bishop. Honored and also challenged. Challenged, because I know that given the experience of the last 6 years for us collectively and individually as bishop I will continue to have to learn in order to be effective in leading us as synod.

Your faithful stewardship is noted in so many ways. One of my great joys is that in 2022 we have been able to, with proper precautions, come together for worship and service. Synod staff has been busy meeting with congregations and conferences, encouraging faithful conversation around leadership formation and visioning for the future.

We also this past August had a visit from our partner Bishop Moses Kobba Momoh from the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Sierra Leone. I was so grateful for the many folks from across our synod who took time to meet our partner bishop and learn more about the ELCSL. We also had fruitful conversations about how we encourage and raise us leaders. Learning much from them about the vital nature of lay ministry education.

In what continue to be uncertain times coupled with economic anxiety our faith and trust in God's abundance is essential. In that I am grateful for the financial gifts you have shared with us. For the months of January-September our records indicate you have shared \$14137.55 with us in undesignated mission support. THANK YOU! Your financial support sustains the ability of the synod to do our work and share 48% of that gift with our wider church as well.


