God's Time

I was curious about something regarding our start time for worship. On Sunday mornings, I go to the Sacristy to check the clock to see if it's time to start worship. Usually, the clock says 9:30 so that means that I better get going!

On a Tuesday morning, I went to check the time, thinking it was about 8:30. The clock said it was about 8:35! This explains a lot! So, I will no longer be using the Sacristy clock to let me know it's time to start worship!

There is a lesson in the midst of all this. Why are we so preoccupied with time? When I was on internship, my supervisor told me not to wear a watch because we are on God's time. That really hit me in all sorts of ways. Why do we feel so compelled to make our worship experience fit exactly into a 1-hour time frame? Why does worship have to be so exact, so perfect? We are imperfect and God knows this all too well. Why are we so preoccupied with time, with details, all the cares and worries of the world when we enter our worship spaces?

I'm all for excellence in worship. That's why I'm usually thinking about my sermon during the time of confession and forgiveness. There is a downside to this though. It's hard to be in the moment and just worship God when you are thinking too far ahead!

How do we become more present in the moment? One thing that I have tried to do as a worship leader is to slow down. Sometimes, I feel like my brain is going 100 miles per hour as I lead the liturgy. I have to remind myself to take a breath, slow down, and don't forget to create those intentional moments of silence. Also, I have to remember that worship is not about me, or the congregation, it's about all of us, worshiping God together! We need to get out of the way and make space for the mystical and mysterious ways of God.




